JULY 2024 | ISTANBUL, GIRESUN (TURKEY)

Project Aladdin and BAU's **International University for Intercultural Leadership** is an annual program supported by UNESCO. It brings together students from Europe, the Middle East, Africa, Asia, and the Americas for two weeks every summer since 2013. Its aim is to develop students' intercultural skills and give them the opportunity to study key issues in international affairs that are linked to coexistence, diversity, the rule of law and good governance.

2024 Theme:

"Inclusive sustainability: women empowerment and social justice"

The International University for Intercultural Leadership will take place from July 15th to 27th, 2024, in Istanbul and Giresun. This year's theme will be "Inclusive Sustainability: Building climate resilience and promoting women empowerment and social justice".

During this year's two-week program, the students will be engaging in an in-depth exploration of the social aspects of sustainable development, with a particular focus on climate resilience and the crucial role of women in local communities. We will examine how technological innovations and sustainable business practices can foster a greener future that is more inclusive and affords a greater protection to vulnerable populations.

By the end of the program, participants will be equipped with sufficient knowledge to design and promote initiatives aimed at securing a more sustainable and inclusive future for all. UNESCO will also hold a workshop to introduce students to its "Toolkit for Intercultural Dialogue", and through various cultural activities, students will discover Turkey rich multicultural heritage.

APPLICATION

Students who wish to apply must be senior bachelor students (third year undergraduate) or master students, preparing a degree. Candidates must be proficient in English and will be selected on the basis of their level of education (third year undergraduate, masters) and their academic performance, with special emphasis on their leadership qualities (their role in student organizations, or their involvement in civil society, for example).

Application must include:

- A curriculum vitae
- A letter of reference and/or a cover letter

PROGRAM CONTENT

The summer school is designed for students who already have a background and/or a strong interest in the following disciplines: social science, political science, environmental science, international relations, sociology, international law, anthropology, and peace and conflict studies. Practitioners and academics who will come from partner universities will conduct lectures and workshops in English.

LOCATION:

Bahçeşehir University is proud to host the 2024 Opening Conference in Istanbul. On July 17th, participants will head for Giresun, where the rest of the program will take place.

THE PROGRAM INCLUDES:

MORNING LECTURES

- Multidisciplinary lectures on a broad range of topics pertinent to the theme
- Academic lecturers as well as practicing specialists
- Learning experience with international peers and visiting experts

AFTERNOON WORKSHOPS AND SITE VISITS

- Small group research/study of selected issues addressed during morning lectures
- Visits of Istanbul and Giresun
- A range of social and cultural activities, including the *Welcome to my Culture* evening, where participants introduce each other to their own cultural background.



RESEARCH PROJECTS

Students will be equally divided into groups reflecting different countries and cultural backgrounds to work together on a common research project. Each group will be required to present an abstract by the end of the summer university. Final research projects are **to be completed after the two-week program** and submitted to an international panel of academics in October 2024.

CERTIFICATE

Students who successfully complete the program will receive certificates naming them "Young Ambassador for Peace and Intercultural Dialogue" from the organizing institutions.
